I (Linda) enjoyed leading devotions at the 5 primary schools and 5 basic schools- it has been a year since I was in the schools and it was so good to be back. Many thanks go to Grace Myers and Megan Alford for making the arrangements prior to the J-Team and for the support and transportation all week. Our building team built a lunchroom with benches and picnic tables for the New Testament Assembly Basic School and brought some needed renovations. The team

enjoyed touring the school on Friday as we had a prayer of dedication together for the school, its teachers and leadership and the students. Wednesday evening, the children in the community were invited for the first week of a 12-week discipleship course led by Grace and Danny Myers. (These are the children who received their Operation Christmas Child boxes back in November with the J-Team.) It was a great night! The team enjoyed some time to relax and debrief on Saturday in Ocho Rios before returning to the states.
