Quarterly 9-day medical, evangelism, teaching, construction



teams serving rural St. Mary, Jamaica. Each team has 3 doctors, 4 pharmacists, 2 nurses, patient screener, 2 clinic clerks, 2 teachers, 4-5 builders and 2 encouragers. (See *J-Teams brochure*)

MEDICINE FUND

The medical cost of each J-Team is about \$4,500 which provides care for 750 patients with critical medications.

TEAMS HOUSE FUND

The Ministry house in Jamaica has a monthly maintenance cost of about \$1,300.

CONSTRUCTION FUND



We have built over 75 homes as a ministry. Each quarterly J-Team we build a home and each home costs \$4,500. Choosing a specific J-Team home to sponsor as a church, Sunday School class, or Small Group is a great way to get involved.

BIBLE TRAINING CENTER of JAMAICA

The goal is for the Training Center to be self-supporting – but we are not there yet. Your gifts enable the school to continue growing until it is able to stand on its own two feet.



GATE MINISTRY

Meeting critical needs of people that cannot provide for themselves, such as food, clothing, shelter, medicine, etc. As a ministry we are purposely located in one of the poorest areas of Jamaica.

TRAINING WORKSHOPS



Bringing professionals to the Island to provide specialized

training for pastors, teachers, guidance counselors, and community leaders. Each workshop costs us about \$2,000.
