Thank you for journeying with us for the past 9 years at Push The Rock. We are so grateful to have walked with this amazing, kingdom-minded staff, to be able to share the gospel using sports as the vehicle, to be able to travel and to invest in kids and families. Mike has enjoyed building relationships through mission trips, the after-school programs, the home school programs, and the CAI gym classes.

We have some big and exciting news! We are in the midst of a transition from Push The Rock to a new adventure. Over the past year, we believed the Lord was leading us into a new season of ministry. Through much prayer, many conversations with the organization, and a trip to Jamaica in November, God made it clear that this was the direction He wanted us to head.

We are starting our story with Teams for Medical Missions (T4MM)! Their office is in the Lehigh Valley, but the ministry focus is in Jamaica. T4MM sends a team of medical professionals, builders, and teachers to Jamaica four times a year. They serve in one of the poorest areas of the island, providing necessary medical care for those who don't have access to it while sharing the Gospel.

Here is our timeline. Mike's official last day at Push The Rock is April 17th, and he will start at T4MM on May 1st. Unfortunately, it looks like Mike will not be physically in the office anymore due to the virus. He'll be working from home until his last day. Please pray for our hearts in this transition in the middle of a crazy quarantine, as Mike really wants to end well.

Part of the transition is also raising additional financial partnerships. We don't take it lightly that you choose to invest in what God has called us to—both in prayer and financially. Thank you! In order to be full time with T4MM, we need to raise an additional **\$3,500/month** and **\$7,500** for initial one-time expenses.
