- Faithful ministry partners in Jamaica serving with us and serving their community which is one of our main goals as we seek to evangelize, equip, encourage, and empower Jamaicans
- The BTCJ under Nickalous' leadership has renewed focus and enthusiasm, 1 new class started in 2023, one to graduate soon and new classes starting in 2024
